

NOVA SCOTIA STICK CURLING (NSSC) - Mandate

The NSSC's Mandate is to promote and develop stick curling within Nova Scotia through a close association with the Nova Scotia Curling Association (NSCA) the focus is in the following areas:

- a. promote the sport throughout the Province.
- b. In conjunction with the NSCA and National Curling Association, determine the playing rules / guidelines.
- c. attempt to find a Stick Curling contact person from each N.S. club.
- d. Coordinate and provide Stick Curling Instruction where needed.
- e. encourage more participants into the game, particularly female players
- f. encourage clubs to create / maintain stick league play within their club.
- g. seek a Title Sponsor for NSSC, also seek other stick event sponsorships.
- h. promote an Annual Stick Curling Bonspiel, and canvass the curling clubs to find a Host Club for the event.
- i. Coordinate provincial play downs in conjunction with the NSCA, including:
 - i.i. Setting dates for the competition.
 - i.ii. Selecting a host club
 - i.iii. Format of play
 - i.iv. Supervision of play
 - i.v. Draw and Schedule
 - i.vi. Awards / Prizes
- j. maintain contact and communication with the other two Maritime provincial stick associations, and assist them in organizing the Maritime event
